TO: RESIDENTS WITH VEHICLES:

Removal of snow after a storm can be a life safety issue. You must be prepared to move your vehicle from your assigned resident lot during snow removal operations.

Please familiarize yourself with the following procedures:

- 1. After the academic lots are cleared, we will begin to plow resident lots. To find out when your parking lot will be plowed, access our website during the snowstorm (or directly after the storm ends) for information. http://rudots.rutgers.edu. You may also call 732-932-7744.
- 2. The information that is listed will tell you:
 - Which lots are being plowed and when your vehicle must be moved.
 - Where to move your vehicle temporarily while your lot is being plowed.
 - What time to move your vehicle back into the resident lot.
- 3. VEHICLES THAT ARE NOT MOVED DURING PLOWING WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE. ADDITIONALLY, \$50 TICKETS WILL BE ISSUED FOR "FAILURE TO MOVE VEHICLE DURING SNOW REMOVAL." (Not knowing the lot was to be plowed will not be accepted as an excuse not to pay the ticket.)
- 4. Plowing of resident lots normally takes place after all academic lots are plowed and is usually done in the evening or on the weekends
- 5. Vehicles must be out of the temporary parking lot by 8am the following morning.

College Avenue Campus Residents

If you are assigned to either the Busch or Livingston campus, you must move your vehicle when the lot is being plowed. If you are parked on the College Avenue Campus during the storm or during snow removal operations, you must move your vehical to the deck (other than the roof).

As the registered operator of a vehicle on campus, you have the responsibility to be aware of snowstorms and snow removal operations.
